
Educational Centre


Articulation paths include; Sound Engineering, Live Sound, Sound Design,

Course Information

Duration: 2 Years. (HNC can be obtained after one academic year)

Entry requirements: Minimum of One Higher (Band C or above, music is highly desirable) plus passes in at least 2 other subjects at NAT 5 or equivalent. Students must demonstrate ability on at least 1 instrument or voice.

Students also have the opportunity to further develop their playing technique through individual study and one-to-one sessions with our expert tutors.





The live performance portion of the course provides our students with the opportunity to build their musical skills as part of a group, develop a professional stage presence and learn about the practical aspects of gigging and the entertainment industry. Our Music Performance students participate in our regular 'Student Showcase' events which take place at Glasgow's leading live music venues.

Our students gain real-life experience in releasing and promoting music. Little Tiger operates as a mechanism allowing students to participate in the music industry and get hands-on experience via the two divisions of Little Tiger; the record label and the promotions company.



Students are responsible for A&R and signing artists through the label, whilst the promotion company works as a vehicle by which our students promote releases by artists. This involves radio, press and online promotion + organising promotional events for artists signed to Little Tiger and on other labels.

Many of the skills gained by students participating in both divisions of Little Tiger are transferable (Law, Licensing, Copyright, Marketing, Finance), with general business communication skills embedded in many processes involved in releasing and promoting records by artists.

Experience the Industry

Academically, students will gain knowledge of fundamental business skills, such as, leadership, finance and organisation. This is combined with music industry specific study areas including intellectual property, copyright, the live performance industry and digital content with technology and innovation. We invite successful leading figures from the music industry to present seminars at Riverside each semester. This offers students the unique opportunity to interact with people who have forged a successful career in the industry.

Fees & Funding

A short guide to our flexible payment options

Partial funding is available from SAAS (Student Awards Agency Scotland) for all of our HNC/HND Music Industry courses. Eligible students can receive £1,205 per annum towards the cost of tuition fees.

Eligible students can also apply for living cost support via SAAS, who have a combination of loans, grants and bursaries available. Student loans of up to £6,750 per annum and bursaries of £1,875 per annum are available depending on individual circumstances. For further details please check the SAAS website.

Our Student Services and Student Finance teams are always available to offer advice and answer any questions you may have regarding finance. They are here for you throughout the application process and, of course, during your time studying at Riverside.

Monthly Payment Plan

Riverside offers flexible payment options for students wishing to pay fees via our SAAS and Non-SAAS funded instalment plans. Candidates opting to pay via our instalment plans will be required to pay a course deposit fee, on or before the due date in July, in advance of student enrolment, scheduled in early August.

Full payment of course fees within 14 days of course commencement entitles you to £100.00 discount on annual tuition costs.

Getting Here

Riverside Music College is situated in Busby, to the South of Glasgow, and benefits from excellent public transport links. We are a short walk from Busby Train station which serves the half hourly East Kilbride - Glasgow Central service.

The First Glasgow Number 6 bus also runs through the heart of Busby via George Square, Victoria Road and Clarkston - or from East Kilbride in the other direction. This is a very regular service, running every 10 minutes at peak times.
